The first half of the session featured an insightful presentation by one of the evening's guest speakers, Imam Imran Khan, who helped bring about a better understanding of some cultural and religious sensitivities which the committee will want to bear in mind when the Syrian family arrives. There's a strong likelihood that the family will be of the Muslim faith and so the talk from Imam Imran Khan really helped bring about some clarity for the committee members as their preparatory work continues.

Afterwards an informative question and answer period took place which really helped address some concerns that might not have otherwise been addressed earlier on in the evening.

During the second half of the information session, guest speaker Ian McBride, Executive Director of AURA (the Anglican United Refugee Alliance) spoke to attendees and shared with them a wealth of knowledge regarding the sort of things that committee members should know in regard to refugee sponsorship and successful resettlement of a family.

AURA will be helping Grace-St. Philip's Family Sponsorship during the entire process of its refugee sponsorship through consultation and other means of support.

Nevertheless, Grace-St. Philip's Family Sponsorship still needs many more volunteers, furniture, household items and monetary donations to reach it's goal of \$56,000.

"We do have an urgent need for people to help George McKelvey with the housing team," said Gerry Meade, the Family Sponsorship Steering Committee Chair. "He needs people to check on various websites like Kijiji and Craig's List as well as in the local papers for rental accommodation. He would also want people to go with him to check out suitable accommodation."
