2024 Tax Receipts

Due to the postal strike, the Department of Finance has drafted legislation to extend the deadline for making charitable donations for the 2024 taxation year to February 28, 2025. While the legislation has not been passed by Parliament, the CRA will accept a claim for donations made before March 1, 2025 on an individual's 2024 tax return. Exceptions are donations made by payroll deduction or by will for a person who died after 2024.

We will be mailing out the 2024 St. Philip's on-the-hill donation receipts shortly for donations received for the period from January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024. If you also wish to receive a receipt for the period from January 1, 2025 to February 28, 2025 to claim on your 2024 tax return, please email the St. Philip's office, (office@spoth.ca) with your request.
